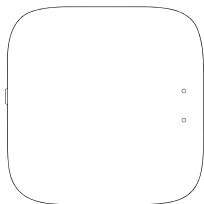

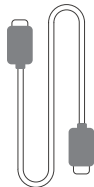

Hub Assembly

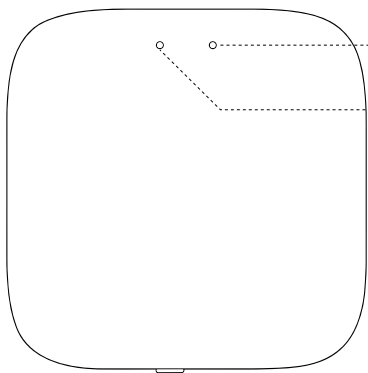


USB-C Power Cable



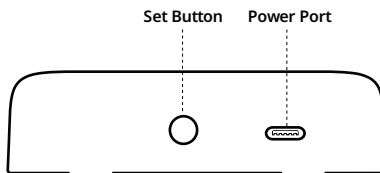

Getting Started

1. This product must be used with the SmartLife App. Follow the instructions to bind the device first.
2. The App requires a smartphone with Bluetooth 4.2 and iOS / iPadOS 13.0 or above, or Android 7.0 or above.

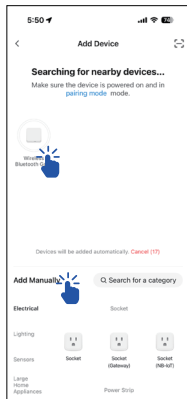
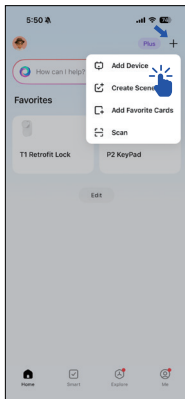

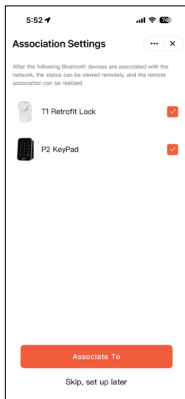


Initial Setup

Add Hub to the SmartLife App



- Make sure you have created a SmartLife App account.
- Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your smartphone.
- Connect the USB-C power cable to power the device.
- On the Smart Life App home screen, tap "+" in the upper-right corner, select "Add Device", and follow the on-screen instructions .
- Discovering devices: When gateway icon appears in the "Discovering devices" list, click to add to the App as prompted.
- Add Manually: Choose "Add Manually">"Gateway Control">"Gateway">"Wireless Gateway(BLE)", add the device to the App as prompted.

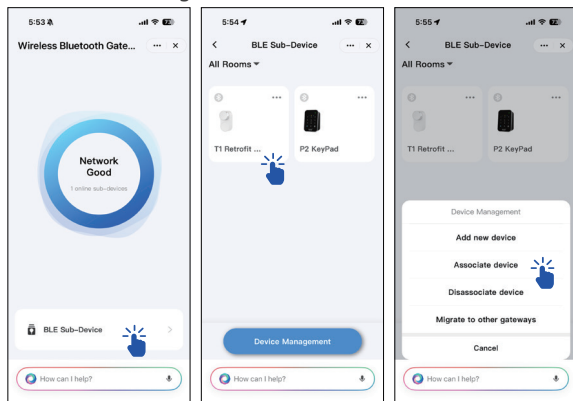


*Note:

- Confirm the Wi-Fi network and passcode, then wait a moment to complete the connection.
- Select the devices you want to control remotely via the hub from the pop-up list, then wait a moment to complete the connection. You can also skip device association and select the devices later in the app.
- You can also skip device association and select the devices later in the app.
- Only 2.4 GHz Wi-Fi is supported. Tap the switch button to select the appropriate network. If reset is required, press and hold the reset button for more than 5s before releasing.

Usage Guide

1. Sub-device Management



- Tap the icon of the Hub, then "BLE Sub-Device">"Device Management", then follow the App as prompted.
- If the BLE sub-device (Lock/Keypad) has already been paired with the app, please select "Associate Device" or "Unassociate Device".

2. Hub Placement

- To ensure a stable connection and optimal performance, place the Hub between your router and smart devices, and as close as possible to the devices that need to be connected (such as Locks and Keypad).
- Although the Hub supports a Bluetooth connection range of up to approximately 10 meters, actual performance may vary depending on the environment.
- Metal doors, walls, and other obstacles may weaken or block Bluetooth signals.
- If the connection is unstable, try relocating the Hub to improve signal quality.

LED Indicator

Red Wi-Fi Indicator

Flashing White	The device is connecting to the network.
Solid White	The device is online.

Blue BLE Indicator

Flash	The device is communicating with the BLE sub-device.
Solid	The BLE signal is normal, and the device is in standby mode.

Voice Control

1. Voice Control

- This device supports Amazon Alexa and Google Assistant.
 - Voice control is only available for devices added in the SmartLife app.
 - Before using voice control, ensure the following conditions are met:
 - The hub is successfully connected to the app.
 - The device to be controlled has been added.
 - Your SmartLife account is linked to the voice assistant.
- *Note: Voice control depends on network connection, so ensure the network is stable.*

2. Limitations

- Control range and effectiveness may be affected by the environment and obstacles.
- Remote control and voice control depend on network connection.

Reset / Restoring Factory Settings

1. Rebind Device

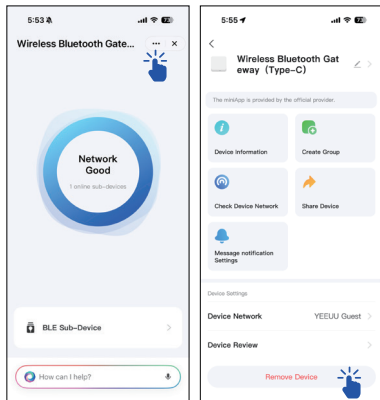
- Press and hold the Set button for 5 seconds until the Hub enters pairing mode.
- The Hub can then be bound to a different App account. App Reset .

***Note: Rebinding the Hub will erase all existing user data.**

2. App Reset

- To reset the device, select it in the app, tap the "✎" icon in the upper-right corner of the device page, then tap "Remove Device" at the bottom of the page.

***Note: Resetting the Hub to factory settings will erase all stored data. Please proceed with caution when performing a factory reset.**



Updating Firmware

- In order to improve your experience, we will regularly release firmware updates to introduce new functions and solve any software defects that may occur during usage.
- When a new firmware version is available, we will send an upgrade notification to your account via our app.
- When upgrading, please make sure your product stays powered on.

Usage Precautions

1. Operational Risk:

- If the power supply is interrupted, remote access will be unavailable, and the lock cannot be locked or unlocked via the app. Monitor the device power status regularly.

2. Firmware Updates:

- Check for firmware updates regularly and install them promptly to ensure optimal performance and security.

3. Operating Environment:

- This product is intended for indoor use or sheltered outdoor use only. It is not waterproof. Avoid exposure to rain or direct sunlight.

Safety Information

Read and follow all safety instructions before using this product.

- This product is intended for indoor use only. Do not use it outdoors.
- Do not expose the device to water or extreme temperatures.
- Keep the device away from heat sources, open flames, and direct sunlight.
- Use only a certified USB power supply that complies with local regulations and safety standards.
- Do not disassemble, modify, or attempt to repair the device yourself.
- This product is not a toy. Keep it out of reach of children.
- Make sure the device is installed correctly. If adhesive mounting is used, ensure the surface is clean, dry, and secure.

Trouble Shooting

Q: App can't find my device.

A: Please power on your device, turn on the Bluetooth of your phone and allow related permission for the "SmartLife" App.

Q: Device could not connect Wi-Fi.

A: Please check whether the Wi-Fi signal is sufficient. The hub only supports 2.4GHz Wi-Fi, not 5GHz. Please make sure your Wi-Fi passcode is correct, and the passcode does not support special symbols

Q: Device list prompts device is offline.

A: Please make sure Wi-Fi connection is correct. If the device connects to the Internet, please check the strength of wireless signal.

Q: I have reset my device, but I can't connect to my hub again.

A: Please remove your device in your App, then rebind your hub.

Compliance
